Public Notice Announcing Rock Island District Mitigation and Monitoring Guidelines

As part of the implementation of the National Wetlands Mitigation Action Plan, Rock Island District has drafted *Rock Island District Mitigation And Monitoring Guidelines* to assist permit applicants preparing compensatory mitigation plans to offset impacts to wetlands and other aquatic resources authorized under the Clean Water Act Section 404 and the Rivers and Harbors Act Section 10 programs. Implementation of the guidelines will improve the success of mitigation and will help meet the goal of no net loss of our Nation's aquatic resources. The guidelines will identify the types and extent of information that agency personnel need to assess the likelihood of success of a mitigation proposal and will provide a basic framework that will improve predictability and consistency in the development of mitigation plans for permit applicants.
