Jim Crow Law Upheld.

Washington—The "Jim Crow" law of Kentucky, requiring different coaches for whites and colored, was upheld today by the supreme court. The South Covington and Cincinnati Street Railway Co. brought a test of the law before the supreme court in an appeal to set aside fines for its violations which has been sustained in the lower courts. The decisions of the lower court were affirmed.

Justices Day, Vandevanter and Pitney dissented from the opinion of the court.
