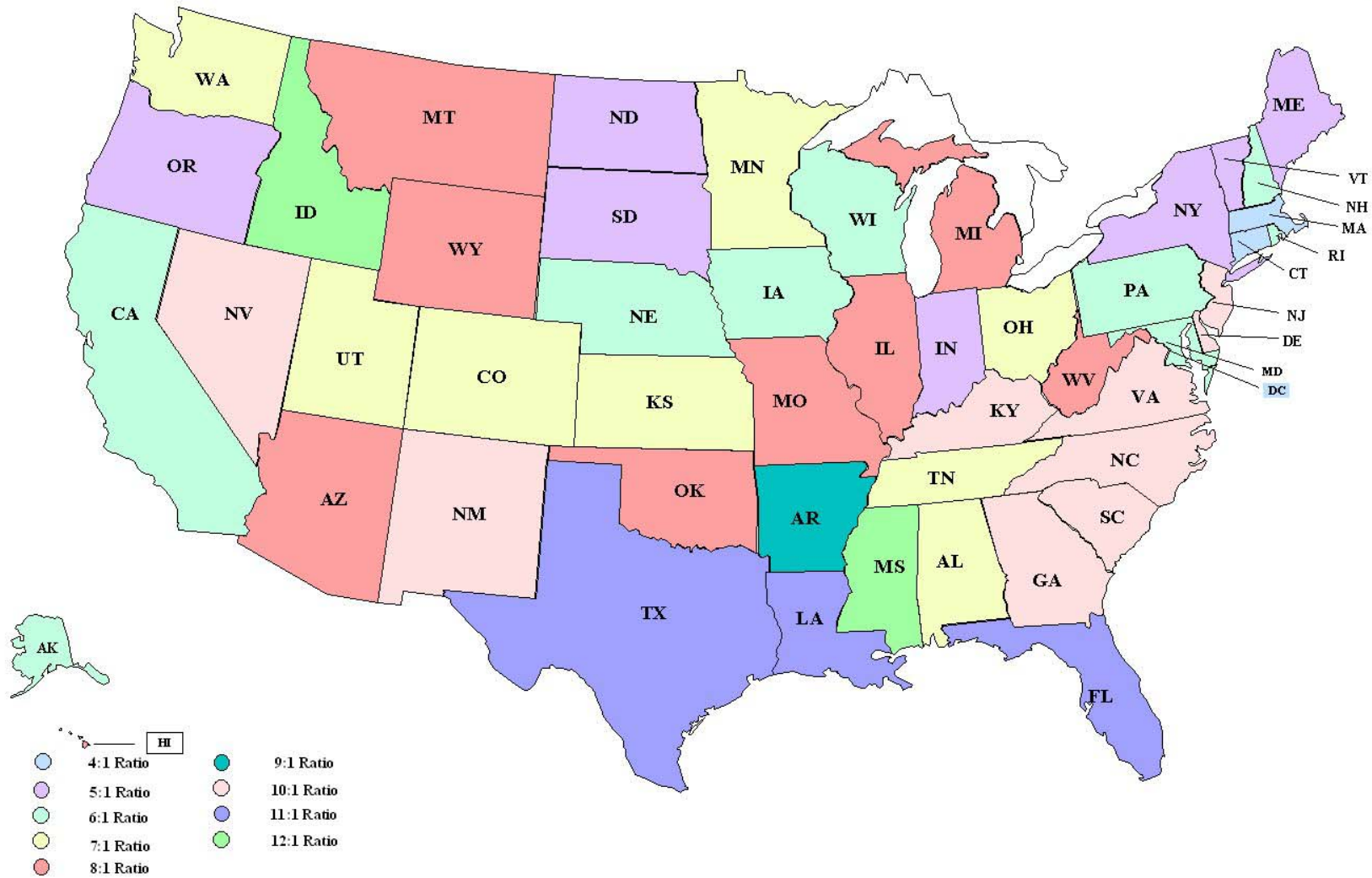
CENTER LICENSING REGULATIONS: INFANT AND TODDLER RATIOS AGE 18 MONTHS
