RULES TO OBSERVE:

Kansas and Federal hunting regulations are enforced.

Some areas are leased. Be courteous to farmer's crops and livestock.

All vehicles must stay on existing roads.

Hunt only in those areas that are open to hunting.

Boundaries on map are approximate. For actual lines, contact the Project office.

Duck blinds may be constructed subject to restrictions. Copies of the duck blind policy are available at the project office.

Target shooting is not allowed.


Hunting is not allowed within 200 yards of boat ramps.

The Wildlife Refuge is closed to hunting, fishing and trespassing during posted dates.
