Important Public Hearing Notice

Coastal Development Permit Application No.: 5-95-283-A1 (Beach Nourishment)

Applicant(s): City of Long Beach Dept. of Parks, Recreation & Marine

Project Description: Amend underlying permit to allow a one-time increase in the amount of beach sand (up to 120,000 cubic yards) to be moved for beach nourishment purposes prior to March 15, 2000.

Project Location: On the beach south of Ocean Boulevard (8th Place to 70th Place), City of Long Beach.

Public Hearing Date: To be determined, February 15-18, 2000, Item No. ____
 Meeting begins at 9:00 a.m.

Hearing Location: Quality Resort - Mission Valley, 875 Hotel Circle South, San Diego, CA 92108 (619) 298-8282.

Hearing Procedures: This item has been scheduled for a public hearing and vote. People wishing to testify on this matter may appear at the hearing or may present their concerns by letter to the Commission on or before the hearing date. Copies of all correspondence will be provided to the Commission if received a minimum of three working days prior to the public hearing. Written comments may be of any length; oral testimony may be limited to 5 minutes or less for each speaker, depending on the number wishing to be heard.

The above item may be moved to the Consent Calendar for this area by the Executive Director when, prior to Commission consideration of the Consent Calendar, staff and the applicant are in agreement on the staff recommendation. If this item is moved to the Consent Calendar, the Commission will either approve it with the recommended conditions contained in the staff report or remove the item from the Consent Calendar by a vote of three or more Commissioners. If the item is removed, the public hearing described above will still be held at the point in the meeting originally indicated on the agenda.

No one can predict how quickly the Commission will complete agenda items or how many will be postponed to a later date. The Commission begins each session at the time listed and considers each item in order, except in extraordinary circumstances. Staff at the appropriate Commission office can give you more information prior to the hearing date.
