MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS (USACE)
THE WATERWAYS EXPERIMENT STATION (WES) AND
DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF FOR INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS (DCS/IP) *Jul 92*

SUBJECT: U.S. Army Research, Development and Standardization Group - UK (USARDSG-UK)
Support of Corps of Engineers Activities

1. **PURPOSE:** This agreement sets forth the relationship between the USACE Directorate of Research and Development (ERO) and the U.S. Army Research, Development and Standardization Group - UK to include:

- a. Personnel space support for the U.S. Army environmental, terrestrial, and atmospheric sciences technical area representative (UK/NATO).
- b. Facilities and administrative support for the above cited representative.

2. **REFERENCE:** AR 10-36.

3. **GENERAL:** Consideration of the most effective and economic means for carrying out the UK-NATO scientific liaison functions of this technical mission justify staff colocation with and mutual support on the part of the USARDSG-UK. Such colocation and support precludes unwarranted duplication of facility, utility, and administrative costs for the U.S. Army.

4. **AGREEMENTS:** (Support and Resource Requirements). The personnel space for the environmental, terrestrial, and atmospheric sciences technical area representative (WES Incumbent) with the USARDSG-UK will be furnished by the Corps of Engineers, with the following provisions:

- a. The WES incumbent's salary, benefits, training and PCS costs will be borne by the Corps of Engineers.
- b. With respect to the WES incumbent's position, personnel selection and position evaluation will be performed by the Corps of Engineers.
- c. The following costs (but not necessarily limited too) will be borne by USARDSG-UK.
 - (i) Office space and utilities.
 - (ii) USARDSG-UK mission related travel.
 - (iii) Office support services, excluding desk computers and printers that are provided by WES.
 - (iv) One half of secretary's salary. Balance of salary is provided by WES.
- d. The Budget Officer, USARDSG-UK, is responsible for fund acceptance from various sources of all funds in the operational and research area, and the coordination of contract action with Finance, Accounting and Contracting Personnel.
- e. COE incumbent serves under the operational control of the Commander, USARDSG-UK, and receives guidance with respect to program objectives and policy. Serves as an expert consultant and adviser to the CDR, USARDSG-UK, in fields of Civil Engineering Sciences and Environmental aspects of related disciplines. Participates as a full Board member of the ERO Selection Board, and makes recommendations to ERO on research plans, projects or proposals submitted by scientists in Europe, Africa, Middle East and India.
- f. The WES incumbent shall be responsive to the interests of the entire Army in the technical area described above. This will include direct attention to the interests of the AMC R&D laboratories, as well as those of the Corps of Engineers.
