INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION/
FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION
AND
U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEER

I. <u>PURPOSE</u>

The purpose of this basic Interagency Agreement is for the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to obtain the expertise in security design possessed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps).

II. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this project is to apply the Corps' expertise to FAA's congressionally mandated project to develop guidelines for the construction of airports.

III. SCOPE

The Corps will accompany the FAA on surveys and prepare reports based on these surveys.

IV. STATEMENT OF WORK

TASKS:

- 1. Accompany FAA on surveys of selected airports.
 - a. During these surveys, the Corps will observe airport maps and schematics, as well as critical areas of the airport.
- 2. Compile observations into a report detailing the following:
 - a. The specific threats, vulnerabilities and recommended protective measures for each airport visited.

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- b. Reports will follow established security engineering procedures developed by the Corps.
- c. Recommendations will be geared to architectural, structural and electrical engineering.

V. <u>DELIVERABLES</u>

Deliverables shall be submitted to FAA's Office of Civil Aviation Security (ACS).

VIII. FUNDING

1. The funding available for this Agreement is \$9,800.00. Payments will be made as reports are submitted by submitting SF-1080 to:

The SF-1080's should cite the Appropriation Code "W/101.0/F020/460/2591" and the Interagency Agreement Number "DTFA01-91-Z-02056".

- 2. In the event that the work called for herein cannot be completed within the estimated funding or if incurred costs are expected to exceed the estimate given within any 60-day period, FAA shall be immediately advised in writing of the anticipated excess costs. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers shall not incur cost in excess of \$9,800.00 without contracting officer approval.
- Upon completion of the work called for under this agreement, the U.S. Army CORPS of Engineers shall refund any unused portion of the funds.
- 4. The total amount for this agreement shall not exceed \$9,800.00.

IX. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The period of performance for this interagency agreement will be from September 1991 through November 1991.

X. AMENDMENTS AND REVOCATIONS

Any change in the work required under this agreement shall be finalized by an appropriate written amendment to the Agreement which shall outline in detail the exact nature of the change.

XI. TERMINATION

The agreement is subject to termination by either the FAA or the CORPS upon written notification to the other party, 90 days in advance of such intent to terminate. Upon expiration or termination of this Interagency Agreement, CORPS shall refund any portion of funds that have been advanced by FAA, but not expended in connection with the work specified herein.

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XII. <u>AUTHORITY</u>

This Interagency Agreement DTFA01-91-Z-02056 is entered into pursuant to the authority of Section 322(C)(1) of the Department of Transportation Act. All other terms and conditions of this Interagency Agreement remain unchanged.
