Summary Report of Occurrences Reviewed From February 12 – 16, 2007

Summary: 23 occurrences at 12 sites reviewed during this period.

Significant Occurrences (1)

Near Misses – 1 occurrence at 1 site

• <u>Nevada Test Site (Significance Category R)</u>. On February 15, 2007, a Security Police Officer (SPO) fired his .40 caliber firearm, damaging a bullet-resistant window in a NTS perimeter access control station. The SPO and another officer had been conducting an unauthorized practice of drawing and dry-firing their weapons. The SPO was relieved of duty and his weapon and ammunition after reporting the unauthorized discharge. [Note: This is the third inadvertent weapons discharge at NTS within the past year.]

Other Trends of Interest:

• <u>Electrical Fire Safety.</u> In two occurrences this week, Y-12 site employees reported odor and smoke in Building 9998 that resulted in employee evacuations. In both occurrences, the fire department determined there was no fire but attributed the smoke and odor to overheated light ballasts.
