Summary Report of Occurrences Reviewed From August 11 – 15, 2008

Summary: 22 occurrences at 14 sites reviewed during this period.

Significant Occurrences (1)

Conduct of Operations – 1 occurrence at 1 site

• NA – Sandia National Laboratories (Significance Category R). On August 12, the ES&H council declared a trend of "Unexpected Equipment Conditions," which was identified during an ES&H Council meeting in July, to be a recurring occurrence. Unexpected equipment conditions are conditions that are typically the result of prior work that is left in an unrecognized hazardous state and not discovered until an event occurs. There were 7 events involving unexpected equipment conditions in FY07, as compared to 13 events through the third quarter of FY08. Nine of the FY08 events were electrical in nature, two were falls and one was related to explosive materials. In each event, the hazard was not known or identified before the event occurred.
