Ports that Act as Designated Ports. The criteria that allow certain ports to act as designated ports can be found in 50 CFR §§ 14.16 (border ports and certain North American wildlife) § 14.17 (personally owned pet birds), § 14.18 (marine mammals), § 14.19 special ports, § 14.22 certain antique articles and § 14.24 (scientific specimens). If your shipment meets the criteria to use the ports identified in the applicable regulation, the port is acting as a designated port for your shipment. If your shipment does not meet the criteria, the port is a non-designated port for your shipment.
