NOTICE TO THE TRADE - MAY 2007

The Department of Agriculture, Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS), Poultry Programs, and the Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) are approving a Standard Yield pilot program for bulk chicken parts. Standard yields for bulk chicken (large or small whole birds) were established at the inception of the Standard Yield pilot program using data gathered from the poultry industry, the National Chicken Council, and through AMS Poultry Programs' Grading Branch staff. Initially, the yields were set high enough to require processors to add meat, assuring that no meat would be diverted from the commodity program to commercial product. Using the established yields for bone-in chicken and boneless chicken meat, the following standard yields for bulk chicken parts will be applicable during the pilot:

Skin	8%	2,880	
Total Yield	62%	22,320	

Standard Yield for Bulk Drums			
B/S Drum	57%	20,520	
Skin	8%	2,520	
Total Yield	64%	23,040
