## **HOLDING PERIOD**

Live dogs & cats acquired by an exhibitor must be held under his/her supervision and control for the required holding period. [2.101]

**Criteria** Live dogs and cats must be held by an exhibitor for the time periods listed below:

| another USDA<br>licensed dealer or<br>exhibitor who has<br>already held the<br>dog/cat for the required<br>holding period | any age                  | 24 hours, not including the time in transit [2.101(a)(2)]                                |
| another USDA<br>licensed dealer or<br>exhibitor who has <b>not</b><br>held the dog/cat for the<br>required holding period | any age                  | 5 full days, not including the day of acquisition and the time in transit [2.101(a)]     |

NOTE: A dog or cat suffering from disease, emaciation, or injury

may be euthanized prior to completion of the holding period. [2.101(a)(3)]

During the holding period, the dog/cat must be: [2.101(b)]

- unloaded from any conveyance it was received in
- removed from any transport enclosure that does not meet the primary enclosure space requirements
- handled and cared for in accordance with AWA standards
