- records for lost or stray dogs/cats must contain:
$>\quad$ an accurate description of the animal
$>$ how, where, from whom and when the dog/cat was obtained
> how long the dog/cat was held by the pound/shelter before being transferred to the dealer date the dog/cat was transferred to the dealer
