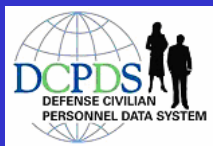

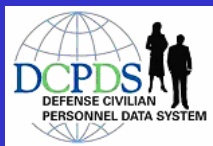




What is My Biz?



- An exciting new web-based Oracle Self Service application within the Defense Civilian Personnel Data System (DCPDS) that allows you, the employee, to:
 - Access and view your personnel information
 - Maintain your own information, including personal profiles
 - Provide input on performance plans (future enhancement)

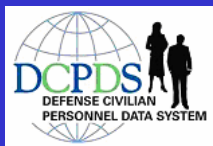
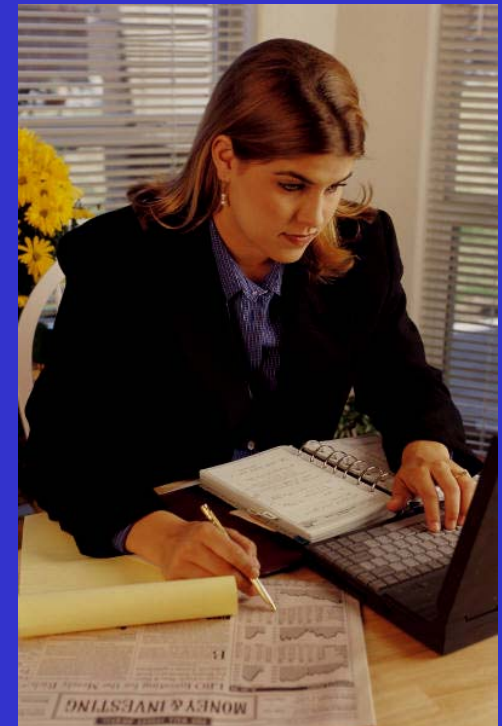




What Information is Available in My Biz?



- Initially, you can view data related to your civilian employment, such as:
 - Position information (current/historical)
 - Salary information
 - Appraisal and Awards information
 - Benefits
 - Appointment information

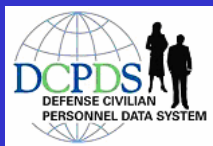




What Can My Biz Do for Me?



- You can update information such as:
 - Race & National Origin designation
 - Phone numbers
 - Handicap code
 - Email address

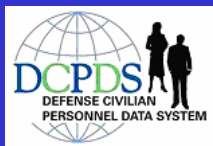




When Can I Use My Biz?



- You will be notified by your Human Resources Office when My Biz is available for You
- Full implementation across DoD is scheduled to occur by summer 2006



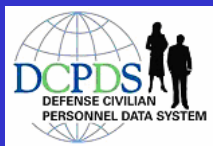


How Do I Access My Biz?

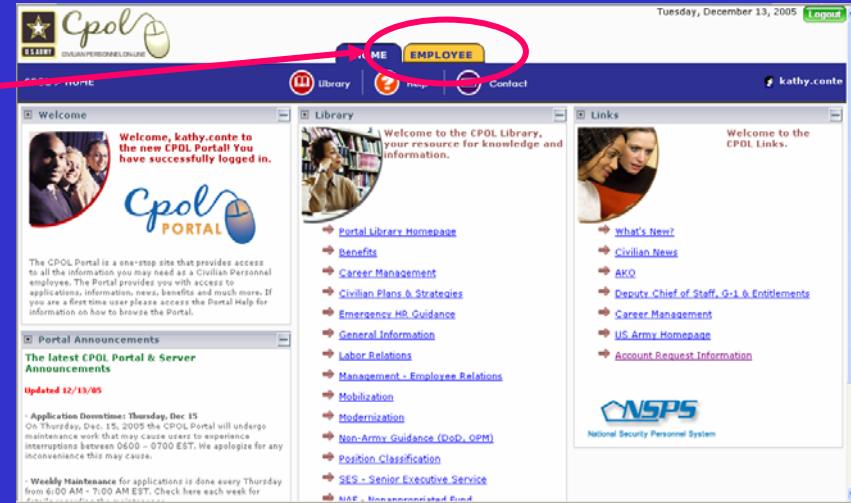

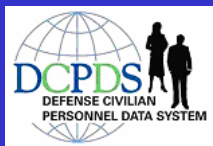
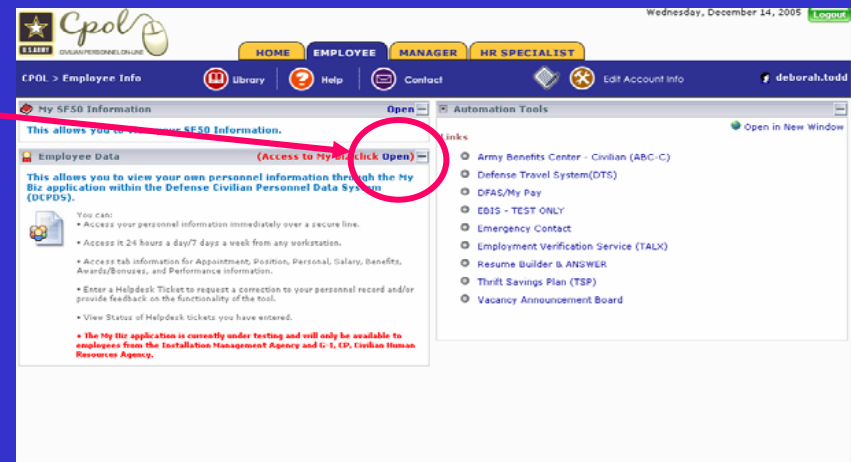


How Do I Access My Biz?

- Then click on “Open” next to “Access to My Biz”

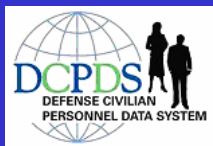

How Do I Access My Biz?



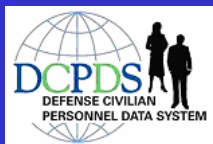
- For current DCPDS users, My Biz will be accessible using your current login and password*

**After June 30, 2006, all users will need to create a new password. (See “New DoD Password Requirements”, page 12)*

- For new DCPDS users, when you log into My Biz for the first time, you will be prompted to provide a User ID and a password (See the next two pages for instructions)

Please Note:

Under Self Service, default passwords are provided to users to initially access the system. After a user uses his or her default password, they are required to change their password before they are allowed to access their account information.



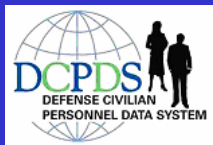


How Do I Access My Biz?



- Army employees on payroll prior to 18 June 2006
 - Your default User ID is your Social Security Number (SSN) complete with the dashes
 - You will have the following initial default My Biz password:
 - 1st character - first letter of first name (upper case)
 - 2nd character - \$
 - 3rd character - first letter of last name (lower case)
 - 4th character - \$
 - 5th character - fourth digit of SSN
 - 6th character - \$
 - 7th character - fifth digit of SSN
 - 8th character - \$

Example: User John Smith with SSN 123-45-6789, will enter:
J\$s\$4\$5\$



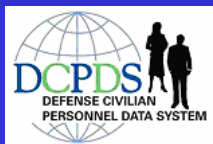


How Do I Access My Biz?



- New Army employees on payroll after 18 June 2006 and all non-Army employees we service (DCMA, DMEA, etc.)
 - Your User ID is your Social Security Number (SSN) complete with the dashes
 - You will have the following initial default My Biz password:
 - 1st character - first letter of first name (upper case)
 - 2nd character - second letter of first name (upper case)
 - 3rd character - \$
 - 4th character - first letter of last name (lower case)
 - 5th character - second letter of last name (lower case)
 - 6th character - \$
 - 7th character - fourth digit of SSN
 - 8th character - \$
 - 9th character - fifth digit of SSN
 - 10th character - \$

Example: User John Smith with SSN 123-45-6789, will enter:
JO\$sm\$4\$5\$

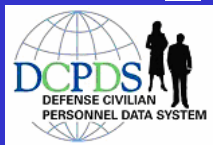




New DoD Password Requirements



- After June 30, 2006, all users will be required to create a new password that complies with the new DoD requirements in order to fully access their Self Service account
 - New passwords must contain a minimum of nine (9) characters, and a mixture of:
 - At least two (2) lowercase letters
 - At least two (2) uppercase letters
 - At least two (2) numbers
 - At least two (2) special characters
 - Passwords expire every 60 days

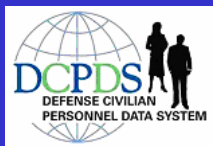




Portal Tools

 - If you have questions as to the definitions of the data elements, check out the Field Descriptions from the Employee Tab in Portal

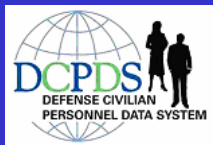
