

Day-Use Area Map

Hunting and Fishing

Orwell Lake is good for walleye, northern, crappie, and red horse sucker fishing and duck, goose, fox, pheasant, Hungarian partridge, and white-tailed deer hunting. Be sure to check with Corps of Engineers or Minnesota Department of Natural Resources personnel for the areas open to hunting and fishing.

Orwell Lake

Do you get excited watching wildlife in a natural setting? Do the mysteries of their actions entice you? If so, then the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers recreation areas at Orwell Lake are the place for you.


Viewing wildlife from the recreation areas is easy because of a wildlife sanctuary located adjacent to the areas. This approximatley 660-acre sanctuary, which is maintained by the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, provides food and shelter for many animals all year long.

Although hunting and fishing are permitted in some areas of the project, these activities are not allowed in the sanctuary.

Recreation Facilities

Orwell Lake has two day-use areas for your enjoyment. One, located at the project's main entrance, has a picnic area, playground, privies and accessible picnic shelter. Tailwater bank fishing is very popular here.

You will find the second area, also called the overlook area, just north of the dam. This area, equipped with a picnic shelter, is excellent for viewing wildlife.



Orwell Lake is located 6 miles southwest of Fergus Falls, Minnesota, in Otter Tail County. This wildlife haven is 15-20 minutes from Interstate Highway 94 and only 30-45 minutes from Breckenridge, Minnesota, via Minnesota State Highway 210. See location map for details.

Lake Access

There are two boat accesses to Orwell Lake (see location map). Use of the south, primitive access, is exclusive to duck/flat-bottom boats. Use of the north access, equipped with concrete planks, is for the larger boats. The lake is limited to boats with motors of 10 horsepower or less.

The Purpose

The main purposes of the Orwell Lake Dam Project are flood control and water supply.

History

Congress authorized the construction of the Orwell Dam with the Flood Control Act of 1948.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers began building the dam in May of 1951 and finished in July of 1953.
