Dear Mr. Chairman:
Your letter of february 5, 1986, asked us to review and analyze data on the number of Department of Defense (DOD) congressional requests for testimony, briefings, written inquiries, telephone inquiries, and other information. We reported the results of that work to you on February 14, 1986, in a report entitled Legislative Oversight: Congressional Requests for Information on Defense Activities (GAO/NSIAD-86-65BR).

You subsequently requested that we analyze DOD's 1985 hearings data to obtain further insight into the extent of congressional committee and subcommittee hearings activity involving DOD witnesses. We reviewed this data in an effort to determine the number and identity of congressional committees and subcomittees (including panels and task forces) receiving testimony from DOD witnesses, the number of hearings identified by subject and by committee and subcommittee, and the number and identity of witnesses from DOD involved in those 'hearings. In order to provide a meaningful measure of the latter category, we confined our analysis to the organizational position of witnesses without regard to the identity of the person holding the position at the time of the testimony. This allowed us to concentrate on the organization rather than the individual in presenting information on "witness positions." The results of our analyses are presented in the appendixes.

In general, our analyses of the information showed that DOD officials appeared at 412 hearings before 100 House, Senate, and Joint commitees, subcomittees, panels, and task forces. The House and Senate Committees on Appropriations and Armed Services and their subcommittees held 261 of the hearings ( 64 percent), most of which involved fiscal year 1986 DOD appropriations and authorizations. (These figures do not include three jointly held committee hearings.) Of the 261, the House Committee on Armed Services held 102; the

Senate Committee on Armed Services, 77; the House Committee on Appropriations, 56; and the Senate Committee on Appropriations, 26. Only 4 other committees held more than 10 hearings involving appearances by DOD witnesses--House Committee on Foreign Affairs, 24; House Committee on Science and Technology, 15; Senate Committee on Foreign Relations, 14; and House Committee on Government Operations, 13.

The DOD data showed that 295 different DOD witness positions appeared at hearings a total of 777 times. Of the 295 witness positions, 10 ( 3 percent) appeared more than 10 times, 22 ( 8 percent) appeared 6 to 10 times, and 263 ( 89 percent) appeared 1 to 5 times. Also, of the 295 witness positions, 147 (about 50 percent) appeared one time.

The witness position appearing most often was the Assistant Secretary of Defense (Manpower, Installations and Logistics), 21 appearances, followed by the Director, Strategic Defense Initiative Organization, 19 appearances, and the Secretary of Defense, 16 appearances. Of the remaining positions that appeared more than 10 times, 4 appeared 13 times, and 3 appeared 11 times.

The leading subject of hearings by far was fiscal year 1986 DOD appropriations/authorizations--137 times. Only five other issues were the subject of hearings more than five times. These were foreign assistance (15), strategic defense initlative (l2), special operations forces (7), DOD reorganization (6), and fiscal year 1985 reprogramuing (6).

## OBJECTIVES, SCOPE, AND NiETHODOLOGY

We reviewea DOD information on hearings for 1985 to determine (1) the number of congressional committees and subcommittees (including panels and task forces) requesting DOD testimony at hearings, (2) the number of hearings, (3) the number of appearances by various DOD organizations, (4) the number of various organizational positions appearing as witnesses, (5) the organizational positions appearing most often, (6) the subjects of hearings, and (7) the hearings subjects appearing most often.

In order to reply to your request in a timely manner, we relied on hearings data compiled by the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) (Legislative Affairs). The nearings data comes from witness logs submitted by the OSD (Comptroller) and the leglslative liaison offices of the Army, the Navy, and the Air furce. The information shows in abbreviated form the names and positions of witnesses, the committees and subcommittees holalng hearings, the subjects of the hearings, and the date of the hearings. This information was not shown in all instances. For example, in some instances, positions of witnesses were not shown and, theretore, we were unable to identify the positions of some witnesses. Also, for some hearings, witnesses were not snown. In adaltion, the information did not show backup witnesses. We did not verify the accuracy of the information proviaea by DOD.

In analyzing the data, we used four organizational classifications; OSD, Army, Navy (including the Marine Corps), and Air Force. Defense agencies, the Joint Chiefs of Staff, and the commanders in chief were included in the OSD statistics. Confirmation hearings (7) and nominee witnesses and iniscellaneous DOD organization hearings (3) and witnesses were not incluaea in our analyses. Also, it shoula be recognized that some hearings subjects may be miscategorized because subject descriptions were prepared by different individuals and, theretore, the same hearings subjects may have been described in ditferent terms.
