

FOREWORD

The purpose of the DOE Enforcement Program is to promote and protect the radiological health and safety of the public and workers in the performance of DOE activities by performing the following:

- I. Fostering compliance with applicable DOE nuclear safety requirements;
- II. Providing positive incentives for contractors, subcontractors and suppliers who perform the following tasks:
 - A. Timely self-identification of nuclear safety deficiencies,
 - B. Prompt and complete reporting of such deficiencies to DOE,
 - C. Root cause analyses of nuclear safety deficiencies,
 - D. Prompt correction of nuclear safety deficiencies in a manner which precludes recurrence, and
 - E. Identification and implementation of modifications in practices or facilities that can improve public or worker radiological health and safety;
- III. Deterring future violations of DOE nuclear safety requirements by DOE contractors; and,
- IV. Encouraging the continuous overall improvement of operations in DOE nuclear activities.

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
