## DAY USER FEES

The Corps of Engineers was given the authorization to collect day user fees in the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1993 (Public Law 103-66). The Law authorizes charging of day use fees in areas that are operated and maintained by the Corps. Areas leased to other entities or private concessionaires are not included in this authority, but similar fees apply under separate programs.

A daily fee of \$1 per person, up to \$4 per vehicle, is charged at developed swimming beaches. A daily fee of \$3 is charged for boat launching at ramps that have restrooms, security lighting, courtesy docks, or other recreation facilities. Children 12 years of age and under do not have to pay a fee.

Picnic shelters are available on a reservation basis at most Kansas City Lake Projects. A fee of \$20 to \$50 for a full day is assessed depending on the size of the facility and the extent of development. Information about shelter availability may be obtained from each lake project office.

Special recreation use fees are already charged for camping. Campground users will not pay the day user fee in addition to the camping fees.

An annual pass may be purchased for \$30 that permits the holder and accompanying passengers in a private vehicle to use all boat-launching ramps and swimming beaches at Corps-operated day user fee areas nationwide without further charges. Annual passes can be purchased through the mail or in person at a Corps's lake office. They may also be purchased at park attendants stations.

## **2008 FEDERAL RECREATION FEES**

Federal law provides for the charging of special recreation use fees at designated Federal recreation areas. Failure to pay user fees may result in a fine.

## CAMPING USER FEES

Camping use fees are charged by the Kansas City District, Corps of Engineers, in three classes of parks: A, B & C. An additional fee is charged for prime sites in some parks. A charge for each overnight stay will be assessed for the use of group camping facilities.

**Class A** parks are those having flush restrooms, showers, access and circulatory roads, trailer dump stations, visitor protection, designated tent or trailer spaces, refuse containers and potable water. There is a minimum charge for each overnight stay in these parks. Reduced off-season rates are offered at Truman, Kanopolis, Pomona, Perry, Stockton, Harlan County, and Wilson Lakes. Contact that lake office for more details.

**Class B** parks have the same facilities as Class A, with the exception that showers are not provided. There is a minimum charge for each overnight stay in these parks.

**Class C** parks are those having sanitary facilities, access and circulatory roads, visitor protection, designated tent or trailer spaces, refuse containers and potable water. There is a minimum charge for each overnight stay in these parks.

## FEES CHARGED BY OTHER AGENCIES

In addition to camping facilities operated by the Corps of Engineers most lakes provide camping facilities operated by other non-federal agencies. These campgrounds are not subject to federal fee legislation. These non-federal agencies will have different fee schedules and do not honor the America the Beautiful, Senior and Access Discount Cards. Please contact the individual state and county offices for more information.

## RESERVATIONS

Reservations may be made for individual campsites in Class A parks operated by the Corps of Engineers. Individual campsite reservations can be made up to 6 months (rolling window) in advance. Group facilities, including picnic shelters and group camps, can also be reserved up to 12 months (rolling window) in advance.

## DISCOUNTS FOR SENIORS & PERMANENT DISABILITIES

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and other federal agencies will no longer issue Golden Age and Golden Access Passports as of January 1, 2007. With the passage by Congress of the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act of 2004, Public Law 108-447, these passports have been replaced with the new *America the Beautiful – the National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass: an Interagency Senior Pass for age-related discounts and an Interagency Access Pass for disability-related discounts.*

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers was not included in the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act, which created the new *America the Beautiful – the National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass* program authority. Although the Corps will not sell or issue the new passes, we will accept only the new *Interagency Senior and Interagency Access Passes* or previously issued Golden Age or Access Passports as proof of eligibility for age- and disability-related discounts. If a previously issued Golden Age or Access Passports is lost, stolen, or worn out, contact one of the agencies listed below.

The only agencies authorized to issue the new *Interagency Senior and Interagency Access Passes* are the National Park Service, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, U.S. Forest Service, the Bureau of Land Management, and the Bureau of Reclamation. The Corps strongly suggests that you call ahead to verify pass availability and office hours before visiting an agency location.

Persons 62 years of age or older and accompanying passengers in a private vehicle will be provided a 50 percent discount on recreation use fees charged at any recreation area administered by the Corps of Engineers, with proof of age using an existing Golden Age or America the Beautiful Card.

Persons who are blind or permanently disabled will be also provided a 50 percent discount on Corps of Engineers' use fees with proof of disability using an existing Golden Access or America the Beautiful Card.

Corps discounts are not generally honored at non-federal recreation facilities, however, state and local agencies often have similar discounts.
