Local Transportation

Estrella Roja buses depart for Puebla from Mexico City International Airport every hour and arrive at Puebla's main terminal, the Central de Autobuses Puebla (CAPU), in the northwest sector of the city. The fare is 130 pesos (approximately US\$ 13.00). Travel time is approximately 2 hours.. Service via Estrella Roja buses is also available every 15 or 20 minutes from Mexico City's TAPO—the Eastern bus terminal.
