On behalf of the Council and the Parties' Ministers of Trade, we offer the following response to the Joint Public Advisory Committee's (JPAC) August 5, 2003 letter urging a joint meeting of trade and environment ministers to take place in the context of the North American Agreement for Environmental Cooperation (NAAEC).

This is an important issue for us, and as noted in previous correspondence with you, the Council will carefully consider the JPAC's advice. We appreciate the JPAC's continued interest in this matter, including the thoughtful agenda item suggestions made by the JPAC at the 10(6) environment and trade officials meeting in Mexico City in March, 2003.

As you know, at the 10<sup>th</sup> Regular Session of the CEC Council in June 2003, we requested that the NAAEC Article 10(6) working group, at a senior level, report back to the Council on a proposed agenda for this potential meeting, as well as their work on crosscutting trade and environment issues of concern before the next Council Session.
