Dear Trade and Environment Ministers:

On behalf of the Joint Public Advisory Committee (JPAC) of the Commission for Environmental Cooperation (CEC) of North America, let me bring to your attention the high degree of interest that we and the North American public have in a joint meeting of trade and environment ministers to take place in the context of the North American Agreement for Environmental Cooperation (NAAEC).

So far, despite announcements made during the three last regular sessions of the CEC Council, no date for the meeting has been confirmed and we have no indication that officials have discussed an agenda recently proposed for your consideration.

Respectfully, ministers, you have a responsibility to demonstrate your support and commitment to NAFTA and NAAEC for ensuring that the basic principles of sustainable development continue to guide your decisions. I strongly believe that such a meeting and an agreement on direction for concrete actions that build on the successes of these both international agreements would convey a very positive message to civil society.

I urge that the planning of a date for this very important meeting be concluded as quickly as possible.
