### North Dakota, 2005

### Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: North Dakota reported 1 case in 2005.
- RATES: North Dakota ranked 51 among 50 states + DC + 3 territories: 0.2 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 3.0 cases per 100,000 population.

# Male-female rates of primary and secondary syphilis

- In North Dakota, the rate among males was 0.3 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 5.1 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 0.0 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 0.9 per 100,000.


# Racial disparities of primary and secondary syphilis

In North Dakota, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 0.2 among whites, 0.0 among blacks, 0.0 among Hispanics, 0.0 among Asian/Pacific Islanders, and 0.0 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.


### **Congenital syphilis**

- RATES: North Dakota had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.0 cases per 100,000.


#### Syphilis: P&S Rates and Congenital Cases, North Dakota, 1996-2005
