I-300 is designed to provide training for personnel who assume a supervisory position within the Incident Command System (ICS). Participants should include those who will hold supervisory positions at the Division/Group, Unit Leader, and Command and General staff levels within ICS.

Audience- Members of Incident Management Teams, State Plant Health Directors, State Plant Regulatory Officials and staff, State Cooperators, Staff Officers, State Operations Support Officers, Officers in Charge, PPQ Officers, Administrative Personnel who have a role in emergency programs and other personnel who may fill Command and staff positions in the ICS.

I-400 emphasizes large-scale organizational development, roles and relationships of the command and general staff, and planning, operational, logistical and fiscal considerations related to large and complex incident/event management. The course also covers the deployment of Area Command, highlighting the importance of inter-agency coordination on complex incidents and events. I-400 is delivered in a classroom setting and lasts approximately 2 days.

Audience- The targeted audience of the I-400 is all personnel who may serve in ICS Command and General staffs positions.
