

Poultry Manure Based Fertilizer Imported to Israel

The following Veterinary Services Certificate (printed on area office letterhead) is required to accompany shipments of poultry manure based fertilizer to Israel.

Prior to completion of the attached certificate:

- VS must inspect the production facility at least annually to verify certifications, and serve as federal level supervision.
- Products must not origin from areas with 30 km of any exotic Newcastle disease (END).
- Exporters must present laboratory test results with the certificate verifying that the exported material (lot by lot) was (were) tested for Salmonella with a negative result. NCIE feels that a negative salmonella test on a manure based product is adequate to verify the other microbiological type statements.
- When letter head certificates are issued, VS Forms 16-4 should not also be issued. If an exporter wishes to have a VS From 16-4, then all below information needs to be placed on the 16-4, instead of issuing a letterhead certificate – not in addition.

IV. Declaration

I, the undersigned official veterinarian hereby certify that:

1. The producer is a plant which is approved by the competent authority for the production of poultry manure based fertilizer for the local market as well as for export to Israel and supervised by an official or accredited veterinarian.
2. No cases of diseases specific to the species included in List A of the OIE code have been diagnosed within a radius of 30 kms from the processing plant and/or the slaughterhouse(s) of origin of the raw material during the last 6 months prior to shipment.
3. The said product has been derived from poultry (chicken) manure
4. The product has been manufactured and packed complying with approved manufacturing practice, sufficient to render it free from pathogenic microorganisms.
5. Samples of the product have been examined prior to shipment at an approved laboratory and found free from human and poultry pathogenic microorganisms, including Salmonellae.
6. The product was stored in enclosed storage and has undergone all precautions to prevent recontamination with pathogenic agents after treatment.
7. To the best of my knowledge and belief the consignment certified herein has not been exposed to radioactive contamination.
