Prior to endorsement of this certificate:

• The manufacturer must be inspected by Veterinary Services and found to produce pet food in compliance with all requirements of the certificate.

With each certificate to be endorsed, the exporter must present:

•	Laboratory results showing that each lot of product being exported has been tested
	as follows:
A.	For salmonella (result must be negative),
B.	Testing for bacterial contamination that can result in a laboratory report with one
	of the following two statements: "total bacterial contamination does not exceed
	500 thousand of microbial organisms per 1 g" or "total bacterial contamination is
	", with the being less than 500 thousand per gram.
•	The Russian importer must obtain an import permit for the product. The Russian
	government issues a letter referencing special permission to import the product.
	A copy of this letter must be provided, and that is the document that is referenced
	in the certificate line "Delivered feeds of animal origin have registered certificate
	issued by Veterinary Department of the Ministry of Agriculture and Food of
	Russian Federation № on 200 ."
