IMPORT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS OF SINGAPORE FOR
DAY-OLD CHICKS FROM THE UNITED STATES

Certification statements to be made on VS Form 17-6:

1. The chicks were hatched from eggs from an accredited pullorum free or pullorum-tested flock;
2. The chicks were hatched in an incubator in which no eggs from untested birds have been hatched, and that the incubator was fumigated or otherwise disinfected prior to the hatch;
3. The chicks were packed direct from the incubator into new disposable boxes for export and had no contact with any birds other than true "day-olds";
4. The chicks have not been vaccinated against any disease;
5. The chicks had been examined and found to be free from any signs of infectious and contagious diseases at the time of export;
6. The chicks were derived from a flock and hatched in premises within a state where no cases of avian influenza type A, subtype H5N2 had occurred during the 12 months preceding export.
