IMPORT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS OF MEXICO
FOR LABORATORY ANIMALS (MICE, RATS, GERBILS, ETC.)
EXPORTED FROM THE UNITED STATES

The animals must be accompanied by U.S Origin Health Certificate issued by a veterinarian authorized by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and endorsed by a Veterinary Services veterinarian. The certificate shall contain the name and address of both the consignor and the consignee. Additional information shall include:

CERTIFICATION STATEMENTS

1. The animals were examined and found to be free of any clinical evidence of infectious or contagious diseases and of ectoparasites.

OTHER INFORMATION

1. The U.S. origin health certificate must be typewritten. Handwritten certificates will be rejected by the Mexican Animal Health authorities.
