2001 Framework for the Environmental Assessment of Trade Negotiations.

Objectives of the EA : inform negotiators and address public concerns

Scope: domestic environmental effects



EA Framework..... continued

Process: three phases of increasingly detailed analysis based on progress in negotiations

 Methodology: environmental analysis flows from economic analysis

Consultations: throughout
