# 2. Program plan for 2005

A first draft of the key tasks, along with a budget, has prepared based on the terms of reference that were set out by each subcommittee. Thus, activities planned will follow closely what was proposed by these groups. # 3. Agenda for March 31<sup>st</sup> meeting

Up until now, a dozen people have confirmed their attendance. Some members have expressed interest in participating but would need financial assistance. (Prior to the meeting) Brian and the Secretariat will discuss the logistics of this event. Santa Monica has kindly offered to pay for the coffee breaks and the lunches. Brian is also exploring an event on April 1<sup>st</sup> where our experts could give talks to municipal representatives from around California.

#### 4. Committee update

The renewable energy (RE) committee met through conference call. They have discussed RE definition, outreach activities and have drafted a background paper. A revised draft will be circulated amongst the whole group soon. Chantal Line will send the names of contacts working on this topic in Mexico to John.

The cleaning products committee has also met through conference call and Scot will share his notes with the group, which will include the proposed pilot project in Mexico.

# 5. International Green Purchasing Network (IGPN)

Following Julie Shanon's suggestion, Yuri Mito from the Green Purchasing Network (Japan) contacted the Secretariat to request NAGPI cooperation in their activities. NAGPI would become a founding member of IGPN. Participants in the conference call agreed that this would be a good idea and Véronique will thus answer the request affirmatively.
