IMPORT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS OF COLOMBIA FOR DOGS AND CATS EXPORTED FROM THE UNITED STATES

The dogs or cats must be accompanied by a health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian, and endorsed by a Veterinary Services (VS) veterinarian. Additional information shall include:

CERTIFICATION STATEMENTS

- 1. The dog/cat was examined and found to be healthy and free of any clinical signs of infectious disease. Note: In general this examination should be conducted within 2 weeks of the departure date.
- 2. Dogs were vaccinated against distemper, hepatitis, leptospirosis, and parvovirus.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. See Certification Statement No. 2.
- 2. Animals over 4 months old must be vaccinated against rabies.

OTHER INFORMATION

- 1. It is recommended that an International Health Certificate (APHIS FORM 7001) be used.
- 2. The accompanying health certificate should be made out at least in duplicate.
- 3. The health certificate does NOT need to be signed by a Notary Public. nor does it need to be stamped by the Colombian Consular office.
- 4. Animals exported in commercial lot numbers must be accompanied by an import permit. Personal pet dogs or cats do not need an Import permit.
- 5. The rabies vaccination certificate must accompany the health documents.
