**IMPORT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS OF GUYANA
FOR BOVINE SEMEN EXPORTED FROM THE UNITED STATES**

The semen must be accompanied by a U.S. Origin Health Certificate issued by a veterinarian authorized by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and endorsed by a Veterinary Services (VS) veterinarian. The certificate shall contain the name and address of both the consignor and consignee and complete identification of the semen to be exported.

CERTIFICATION STATEMENTS

1. At the time of semen collection, the donor bulls were free from clinical evidence of infectious and parasitic disease, including brucellosis, infectious bovine rhinotracheitis (IBR), bovine viral diarrhea (BVD), tuberculosis, trichomoniasis, and campylobacteriosis.

Testing Requirements

1. Brucellosis - any official test; within 12 months of collection.
