SUBJECT: Green Procurement Online Course

Green procurement is the purchase of products and services with favorable energy or environmental attributes in accordance with federally-mandated "green" procurement preference programs. The Department of Defense's Green Procurement Program is a comprehensive strategy for implementing environmentally preferred practices while sustaining the overall mission.

A green procurement online course, CLC 046, has been developed by members of the DoD's Green Procurement Program Workgroup in coordination with Defense Acquisition University. The overall intent of this course is to identify the objectives and background of DoD's Green Procurement Program.
