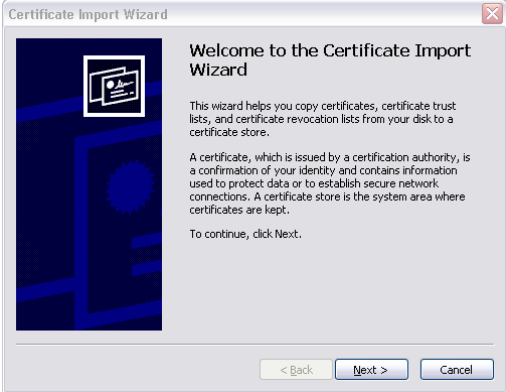

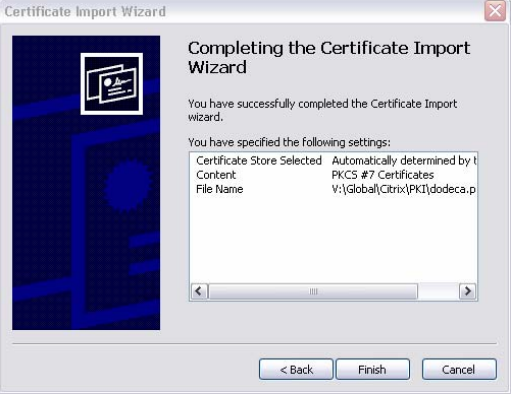



## Installing the DOD Root Certificates

<b>Acquire the Root Certificates</b>		
<b>1</b>	<p>There should be three files supplied:</p> <p>dodeca.p7b dodroot.p7b dodroot_CA2.p7b</p> <p>Save the files on your machine, noting the path to the files.</p>	
<b>Installing the DOD Root Certificates in Windows XP and Windows 2000</b>		
	<p>You will need to complete the following steps for each of the files listed above.</p>	
<b>2</b>	<p>In Windows Explorer, navigate to the folder where the files exist.</p>	
<b>3</b>	<p>Right click on the certificate file to be installed into the machine. From the menu, select <b>Install Certificate</b>.</p>	
<b>4</b>	<p>The Certificate Import Wizard screen should appear. Click on the <b>Next</b> button to continue.</p>	
<b>5</b>	<p>In the <b>Certificate Store</b> screen of the Certificate Import Wizard, click on <b>Next</b> to continue.</p>	

<p><b>6</b> In the <b>Completing the Certificate Import</b> screen of the Certificate Import Wizard, Click on <b>Finish</b> to continue.</p>	
<p><b>7</b> A security warning may appear asking if you want to install the certificate. Click on <b>Yes</b> to continue.</p>	
<p><b>8</b> A small dialog box will appear indicating that the Certificate Import was successful. Click on <b>OK</b> to complete the certificate install process.</p>
