A. CPO Report

Activities related to transformation: Attended meeting regarding Warrant Officers in the Corps on 24 Sept. There are tactical plans needed for career development: PTA, and COTA will have associate degrees.

Fit testing for respirators will be required, which means the facial hair for males will have to be eliminated. Therapy category is leading in CCRF membership with 60% participation. For promotions there will be five (5) precepts definitely, which are still under consideration. It is highly recommended that every officer must review his/ her record, OPF and PIR make sure everything is up to date and complete the Officer Statement as well as supervisor recommendation. Submit all documents including updated CV to your OPF before December 31, 2003. The blue book is now on line.

Promotion Board: new recommendations Please review CPO's electronic communication that was sent earlier. (Due to a technical failure exactly spoken words during the meeting were not recorded)

FAQ page: Bill Knight is working on this and final instruction is not yet finalized

CAPT McGarvey will work with CAPT Canton re: physical standards for recruitment DCP is in dire need of help. CAPT McGarvey recommended that people ask for agency support for temporary detail to DCP.

AMSUS: There will be a booth at AMSUS in San Antonio for the Healthy Lifestyles initiative offering BMI measurements. Also there will be a joint service presentation at the Medical Service Corps Section meeting. The topic is "Role of Therapists in the Primary Responders Team". In addition to CAPT McGarvey, the speakers will be COL Eckburg, USAF, CAPT Ireland, USN and LTC Moore, USA.

B. TPAC Chairperson

CDR Balash reported that she is now the vice chair for PAC Chairs.

Just by being on the PAC does not automatically qualify a member for an award. Person recommended for award must have 30 days of service on the PAC. Order of rank, this award is below the citation.

LT Jeff Richardson was acknowledged for an outstanding end of year of report for JOAG.

CDR Balash reported a staffing issue: Yakama Nation has a tribal position open for diabetes care: Exercise and Foot Care. Public Law 638 and Self-governance has posed limitations on ability to hire CO's to the tribal positions via the IHS MOA, despite the fact that one of the applicants is a Native American.

Report of the Therapist Billets Review Task Force

Therapist Billets Review Task Force Members:

During the 22 AUG 03 TPAC meeting, a concern was identified regarding the current structure of the Therapist Category standard billet series. Due to limitations in the existing database utilized at headquarters, there is no means of easily distinguishing between the four disciplines represented within the category using our current consolidated standard billets. The consolidation of therapist billets has lead to errors in classification of officers by personnel specialists across agencies in the USPHS. Presently the default civil service equivalency designator is 0633, which is for Physical Therapist. This default designation is not appropriate for all Therapist Category officers.

The expectation of the prior Billets Review Task Force (created in JUL 01) was that appropriate discipline designation would be accomplished via a qualifying statement or alpha designator (PT, OT, SLP and AUD) at the top of the billet description. (Excerpt from their report below). LCDR Ron Keats has indicated that this means of differentiation is not feasible with the existing billet database. LCDR Keats serves as the Billets Coordinator in the Division of Commissioned Personnel.

Excerpt from TPAC Position Paper 19 DEC 01

Consolidate the number of standardized billets. Distinguish professional discipline with a qualifying statement rather than separately numbered billets. This should reduce the number of standardized billets by almost two thirds.

Recommendation:

Following discussion with LCDR Keats, it is the recommendation of the Therapist Billets Review Task Force that the current standard billets structure for the Therapist Category be expanded to three series to facilitate appropriate identification of the different disciplines. The three series are as follows:

0631=Occupational Therapist; 0633=Physical Therapist; 0665=Speech Language Pathologist / Audiologist.

Taking this action will facilitate the correct matching of discipline designation and civil service position description by personnel departments across USPHS agencies utilizing the existing billet database.
