#### II. REVIEW AND ADOPTION OF AGENDA:

The agenda was reviewed and adopted with a motion by CDR Shapiro and seconded by CDR Figueroa.

#### **III.** REVIEW AND ADOPTION OF PREVIOUS TPAC MINUTES:

August 2006 meeting minutes were provided and approved via e-mail to all TPAC members. Minutes were posted to TPAC Web site in September 2006. The August 2006 meeting minutes were adopted by acclimation.

#### IV. GUEST SPEAKER(S): CDR Hanner, OCCO, DCCTCD

CDR Diane Hanner discussed promotion preparation:

- CDR Hanner stated officers need to stay current with all requirements. Officers should place all documents needed for promotion in their eOPF by 31 December (the earlier, the better).
- The COER needs to be to the reviewing officer by 6 November and to OCCO by 20 November. Check your eOPF on 21 November for your COER.
- The next BOTC occurs 28 November.
- Officers need to log on to the OFRD web site every three months.
- Complete a one year Report of Medical History and update before your previous report expires. The report needs to be valid at the time of promotion effective date.
- Frequently review the asked question section on the CCMIS web site.
- Ask your agency liaison, PAC, and mentor for assistance and council.
- Check the TPAC web site for promotion benchmarks.
- CDR Hanner stated you should not have a missing COER, missing officer statement, out of date CV or out of date license. Officers are required to be basic ready and have a NACI security clearance as well.
- The Officer Statement should be presented in a clear and concise format.

Q & A: CDR Balash asked about NACI documentation. CDR Hanner stated the NACI is located in the pink section of your eOPF. A new NACI is required every ten years.

CDR Gaustad asked where the readiness checklist is located. CDR Hanner reported it is on the OFRD web site.

LCDR Richardson asked about documentation for immunizations. Documents submitted should contain the medical center letterhead and provider's signature/stamp.

#### V. REPORTS

# A. <u>CPO</u> Report: CAPT McGarvey was not present. CDR O'Neill-Manrique presented his report.

- CAPT Dean Coppola, OCCO, is the new JOAG advisor.
- Thirty officers were selected to profile in local papers for Commissioned Corps promotion/visibility.
- The Surgeon General's call to action on underage drinking will be released in late November or early December.
- The new call-to-active-duty system is initially limited to USA Jobs.
- Deputy Secretary Azur has requested documentation from each Agency on the use of Commissioned Corps officers through 2008.
- RADM Furman, Director, OCCO, noted five percent of current Corps officers do not have a current license.
- The policy on readiness is still in the process of being approved. The FMRB is still pending.
- OCCFM is creating management plan work groups. Working policy integrated groups will look at policy before implementation. Officers are encouraged to contact their agency liaison if interested in participating.

- RADM Babb has been designated the new Regional Health Administrator for the Kansas City, MO region. His vacated OFRD position is now open.
- The CPO board is working with the Jr. COSTEP program.
- Time commitment by officers being discussed.

Q & A: CDR Balash asked about the Congressional review of NIH Corps officers. CDR O'Neill-Manrique was unable to provide additional information.

#### B. <u>TPAC Chair Report</u>

- Nothing to report.

C. Administration Committee: LCDR Dahl deferred to the committee report.

**D. Information Management Committee:** CDR Figueroa stated the TPAC web site has been updated. LCDR Feda is the new JOAG category representative. Historian CDR Whitehouse-Lief reported the grant request from the Commissioned Officer Foundation has been secured. A meeting is being held in November to develop the Commissioned Corps web site. LCDR Tanzillo is investigating the possibility of having a category list-serve.

**E. Readiness Committee:** CDR Shapiro reported the Therapist Category readiness level is currently 73.7 percent. Some officers are not basic ready because they have not logged on to the OFRD web site within three months or selected a deployment role. LCDR Golding is the new Healthy Lifestyle Chair. The Readiness Committee and Dietitian Category have submitted an article on the fit-for-life section. CDR Shapiro clarified the differences between the deployment tiers: tier one and tier two officers have supervisor pre-approval. Therefore, when called, these officers will deploy. Tier three officer's supervisors have been notified but still need approval prior to deployment.

**F. Strategic Growth Committee:** LCDR Boles deferred to his report but stated he is seeking volunteers to chair subcommittees.

**G. Professional Development Committee:** LCDR Randall reported the Education Subcommittee is working on an advanced practice web page. Publication citations should be sent to LCDR Feda. LCDR Feda is also compiling information on category specialty certifications. Please send information on your specialty certifications, including certification number, to LCDR Feda. The Awards Subcommittee has asked to have officers begin thinking about category awards. Please refer to the TPAC web site for award specifics. LCDR Randall stated the category benchmarks have been updated. The CV summary sheet is being revisited while the CV format is being discussed. LCDR Randall reminded officers that readiness waivers may be granted before delivery or post-partum.

#### H. Therapist Category Liaison: No report.

#### VI. OLD BUSINESS

<u>Billet Description Task Force:</u> CDR Fultz reported the task force met several times with representatives from each discipline. It is attempting to account for the transformation process during its work. The task force is looking at the fifty-eight therapist category billets on the web site. Most have been reviewed. The clinical specialist billets have been discussed as well. The task force goal is to complete its work and recommendation before the December TPAC meeting.

<u>Legal Issues/Federal Government Therapist:</u> CDR Figueroa stated the task force has not met. She is asking for an occupational therapist and audiologist to volunteer to investigate their clinical scope of practice. The task force will attempt to look into scope of practice and standardize across agencies. No current document states officers are protected under the law. An attempt will be made to provide a document so basic privileges are available wherever officers work. Would like to put the task force on hold until this topic is discussed at the Navajo Chiefs Meeting on November 15

#### VII. NEW BUSINESS

Update Policy and Procedure Manual- Special Assignment Award/Activity Tracking Log: LCDR Richardson recommended changes to the TPAC policy and procedures to ensure the TPAC Chair has responsibility for the special assignment award given to PAC members. A special assignment activity log has been created to help PAC members document attendance and participation which can be confirmed by the TPAC Chair. As of now, only PAC members shall be awarded the special assignment award for thirty days of PAC participation. Under the new process, the appointment letter must be submitted with the log to confirm participation and work for the PAC. The documented days of work do not need to be consecutive days and two or more hours a day equals a day of work for the PAC. A motion to approve the changes to the TPAC policy and procedures was made by LCDR Richardson. CDR Shapiro seconded the motion. The motion passed by acclimation.

<u>Task Force for Core Clinical Competencies/Career Pathways:</u> CDR O'Neill-Manrique stated the task force will account for the four functional categories: clinical, public health, mental health, and research. It will amend the current career pathway document to include the functional categories. LCDR William Pearce and LCDR Jim Cowher are co-chairs. Task force members include LCDR Michelle Baker, LCDR Tarri Randall, LCDR Alicia Souvignier, and LCDR Henry McMillan. CDR Jeff Fultz is an ad-hoc member to liaison with the Billet Review Task Force. The task force will be placed under the Strategic Planning and Development Committee.

<u>Special Pay Task Force:</u> CDR Shapiro will chair a task force to investigate the special pay for purposes of retention, accession, hardship, and clinical specialty. CAPT Rebecca Parks, LCDR Henry McMillan, LCDR Andra Battocchio, LCDR Michelle Baker are members.
