

Ballast Water Management (BWM) Equivalent Reporting Program Application

The U.S. Coast Guard's Equivalent Reporting Program offers an alternative for an Owner, Operator, Master, Agent, Person-in-Charge or Charterer to submit required Ballast Water Management (BWM) Reports in a single batch report on a monthly basis, instead of on a port-to-port, pre-arrival schedule as required under 33 CFR 151.2041(b).

This application must be completed and submitted as an e-mail attachment to the Coast Guard's Environmental Standards Division (G-MSO-4) via the following e-mail address: environmentalstandards@comdt.uscg.mil. Applicants may be vessel Owners, Operators, Masters, Agents, Persons-in-Charge, Charterers or other responsible parties. All applicants will receive a reply e-mail from the Coast Guard indicating whether or not they are accepted into the Equivalent Reporting Program. Following acceptance, vessel-specific BWM Equivalent Reporting Forms will be e-mailed directly from the National Ballast Information Clearinghouse (NBIC) to the point of contact listed for each vessel in the application. The vessel-specific form is designed to be reused by the submitter and will be the only format accepted by the NBIC.

All vessel ballast water reports must continue to be submitted under 33 CFR 151.2041(b) until the month after the applicant has received a vessel-specific BWM Equivalent Reporting Form from NBIC for each vessel listed in the application. Once in the program, completed BWM Equivalent Reporting Forms are to be directly submitted to the NBIC (monthly@ballastreport.org) monthly, on or before the designated due date for each vessel or fleet of vessels. If any of the information in this application changes, a new application must be filed.
