In Federal Fiscal Year 2006 the Infant/Toddler Child Care and Development Fund Set-Aside = \$3,721,983

2,216 children served by 24 grantees are in Early Head Start (206 Early Head Start Funded Enrollment)

51% of all the requests for child care to the child care resource and referral programs were for infant and toddler care







### In Center-Based Care the staff-to-child ratios are

1:4 for 6 weeks to 14 months; 1:5 for 15 to 23 months; 1:8 for twoyear-olds; 1:10 for 3-year-olds (State Licensing Regulations)

#### In Family Child Care the staff-to-child ratios are

1:8 (with up to 5 children under the age of 5, and of these, up to 3 of these may be under 24 months) OR 1:8 (with up to 6 children under the age of 5, and of these, up to 2 may be under 30 months) (State Licensing Regulations)
