53% of all the requests for child care to the child care resource and referral programs were for infant and toddler care





Child Care in America: 2006 State Fact Book, NACCRRA

In Center-Based Care the staff-to-child ratios are

1:5 or 2:11 for infants; 1:6 or 2:13 for 1 year olds; 1:8 for 2 year olds; 1:13 for 3 year olds (State Licensing Regulations)

In Family Child Care the staff-to-child ratios are

1:4 infants up to age 12

1:6 with no more than 4 children in care for compensation, and no more than 2 of them under 1 year unless a sibling group (Certified Home Providers)
