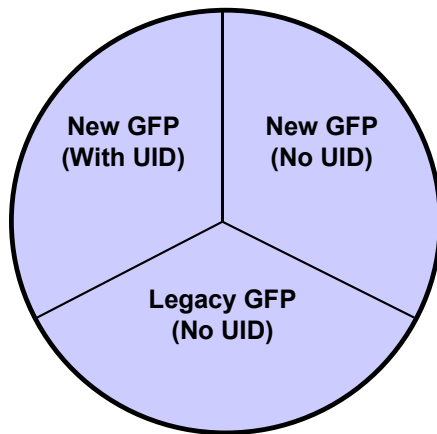

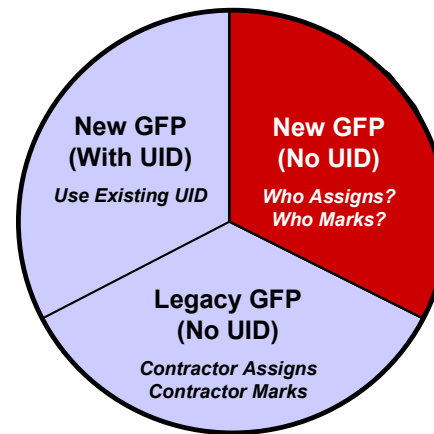

Macro Scenarios for GFP from a UID Perspective



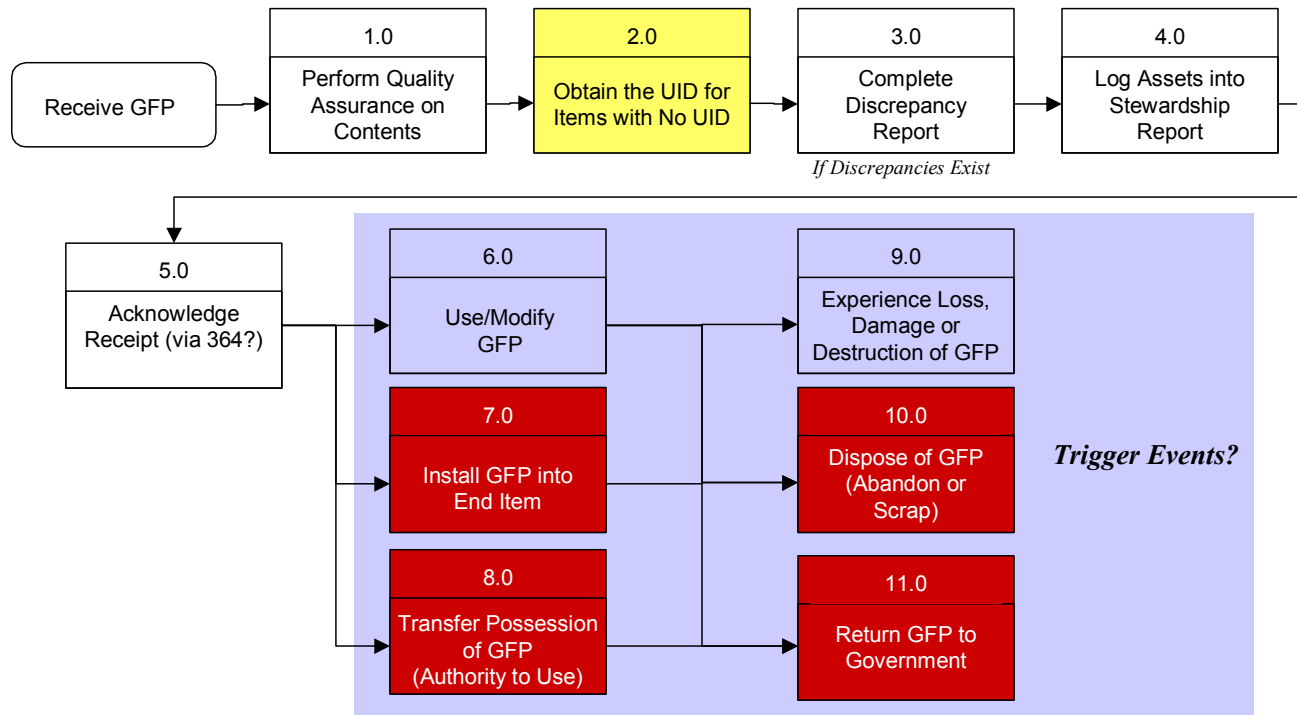
Macro Scenarios for GFP from a UID Perspective

Receipt of New GFP by a Contractor (from the Government)



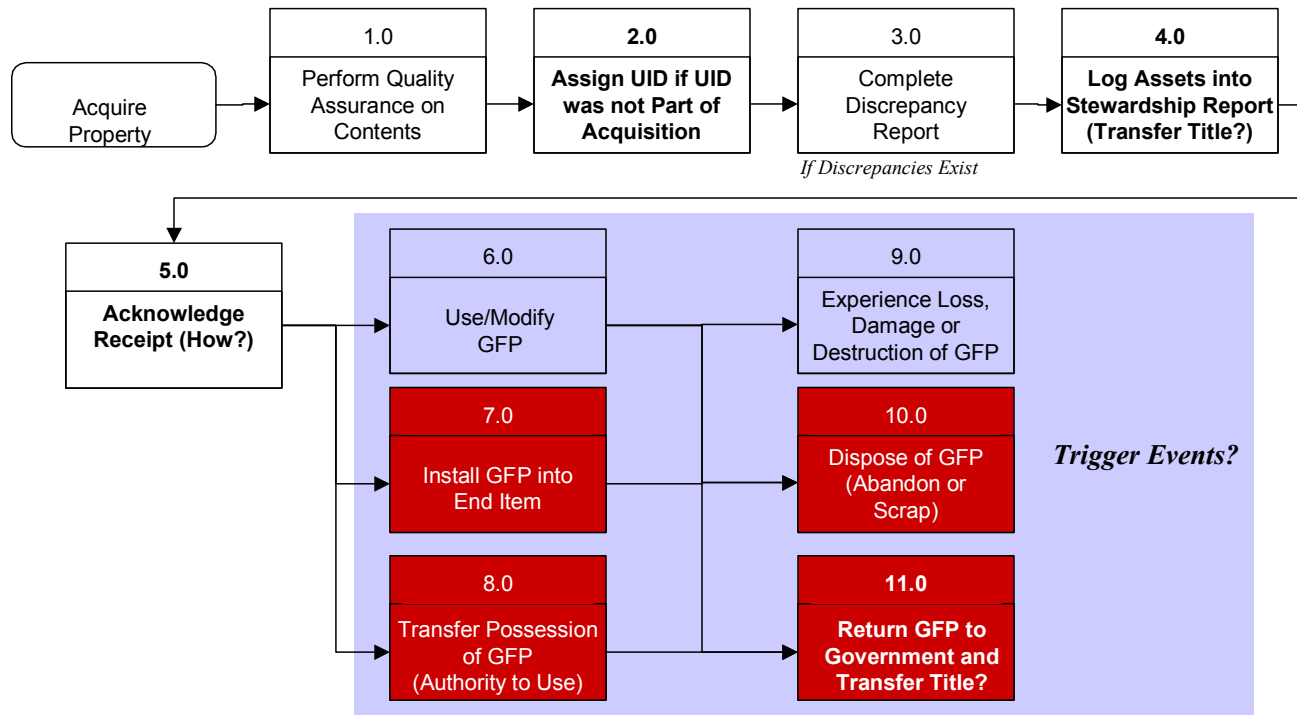
Key Questions to Resolve:

1. Who assigns the UID for new GFP delivered to the contractor?
2. Are the events in red the only trigger events that create a requirement for the contractor to mark the item with the UID?
3. What data is delivered (along with the item) by the government? What data is entered (by the contractor) as part of the initial stewardship record? What data is entered at each trigger event?
