

Crossroads operates a monthly food purchasing co-operative that has over 8,000 members in seven counties. Members save up to 50% on groceries and volunteer at least two hours per month in the community. The greater the number of people participating, the lower the cost of food. Outreach is focused on people who need help stretching their food budgets the most -- food stamp recipients, seniors, and the working poor.

THE CROSSROADS THRIFT STORE

- Clothing and household items given away free by referral
- Over 13,000 people receive free items annually
- Items also sold at the lowest prices in Salt Lake (86% given away free)
- Thousands of dollars worth of new kids' shoes and clothing given away free each year

WHO WE SERVE

- 27% are homeless, including whole families
- 39% are under 18 years old
- 51% have no income
- 25% have income from work, but can't make ends meet
- Utah ranks fourth in the U.S. for number of residents experiencing hunger according to the USDA (5%)
