

PLCS – Strategic Plan

- WHY PLCS (i.e., what's in it for the stakeholders?)
 - Improves maintenance integrity and cycle time
 - Standardized feed to IUID Registry (i.e., common DEX structure)
 - Facilitates:
 - 2-way exchange among stakeholders with data synchronization
 - Performance Based Logistics
- WHAT data needs to be exchanged to meet IUID requirements?
 - As built
 - As maintained
 - UID DEX (e.g., product as an individual)
- WHO needs to approve what?
- HOW do we socialize the plan outlined above?
- WHEN, who and how can join? Target Jan 1, 2007
 - How will contracts get modified
 - Process approvals through functional requirements
- WHAT is the process impact to integrate technical data using UID
- WHAT is the long-term strategy

PLCS – Strategic Plan cont'd

- Elite Demonstration slated to complete in early July
 - Goal: Demonstrate use of Aviation DEX (resident on OASIS website) to exchange maintenance data (including UII) between Sikorsky, DA2410, NAVAIR Nalcomis/OOMA
- Measurable outcome of ELITE: Reduction in man-hours to complete data exchange and/or inputs to maintenance systems for newly delivered aircraft/equipment

UID Program Top Level Program Goal for PLCS

- 1. Facilitate maintenance data exchange between DOD and Industry and the UID Registry**
- 2. Facilitate 2 way flow of maintenance data between DOD stakeholders in order to ensure consistent data across maintenance systems and UID registry**

 - Follow on system engineering to make the demo system more robust

 - Technical: DOD & Industry Endorsement/Acceptance
 - Contracting impact
