SUBJECT: Class Deviation-Relocation Costs

I authorize a class deviation from the cost principle at Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 31.205-35, Relocation costs, when contracting with United Defense, L.P., Armament Systems Division (ASD).

This class deviation authorizes the use of lump-sum reimbursements for the relocation expenses identified in FAR 31.205-35(a)(1) and (2) on all contracts with United Defense, ASD, pursuant to an advance agreement with the Government. This class deviation is effective from September 1, 2001 through December 31, 2004.
