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Warehousing Standards

- Most Cost effective and efficient RAs
- Timeframes for evaluation
- Evaluations of Current Distribution Systems
 - **▼** Delivery frequency
 - **×** Delivery hours
 - **▼** Delivery cost
 - **×** Placement of Commodities

Standards Continued

- Method of notification of arrival
- Method of ordering commodities

Storage Standards

- Sanitary and free from infestation
- Safeguards against theft, spoilage or loss
- Maintain proper storage temperatures
- Store foods off the floor
- Obtain all required Federal, State and Local health inspections or approvals

Contracts

- Contracts effective no longer than 5 years
- Contracted facility meets all required standards
- USDA Commodities clearly identified
- Perpetual Inventory System maintained
- Annual Physical inventory
- Provisions for immediate termination of contracts

Contracts Continued

- Insurance coverage to cover value of USDA Commodities
- Record retention at Distributors
- Contract termination by either party

Warehouse Reviews

- Distribution Warehouses must be reviewed annually
- Responsibilities of SDA
 - Inventory Management
 - Excessive inventories
 - Physical inventory
 - o Overages/Shortages
 - o OS&D's
 - Tracking requirements

Financial Management

- Distribution Charges
- Cost of Living Contract Increases
- Fuel Increases
- Claims against the Contracted Distributor
- Tracking values of Commodities for RA'S

Transportation Requirements

 Van trucks for delivery of dry groceries and refrigerated trucks for delivery of refrigerated items

• Single Compartment refrigerated trucks (0 degree) for separate or integrated deliveries of dry groceries, frozen and refrigerated

Transportation continues

 Dual compartment trucks for combination deliveries of dry groceries and refrigerated items

Warehousing/Distribution

- 50 States/50 Different Distribution Systems
