## STATE DISTRIBUTING AGENCY (SDA) RESPONSIBILITIES



## **Recipient Agency Eligibility**

- SDA determines eligibility of agency applying to participate in program;
- SDA must consider past performance of agency applying to participate in program;
- Once approved, SDA enters into written agreement with agency and makes commodities available;

- §210 & §220 School Food Authorities
- §226 Child & Adult Care Food Program
- §250.41 Charitable Institutions
- §250.42 Nutrition Services Incentive Program (formerly Nutrition Program for the Elderly)
- §225 Summer Food Service Program

## **SFAs and Commodity Schools**

- NSLP, commodity schools, and others;
- National per-meal value, # meals served;
- Commodity offer value no less than the average per meal value;
- Bonus foods for other schools.

## **SFAs and Commodity Schools**

- Must offer SFAs full range of foods;
- Offer and refusal system;
- Use of donated foods for training.



#### **Charitable Institutions**

- Tax-exemption and agreement specs;
- Report number meals served and needy persons (financial data);
- Adult correctional institutions (rehabilitation certification of 10 hrs/wk to majority of inmates);
- Donated foods by average number of meals served daily to needy persons;
- Surplus foods, as available.

## **CACFP**

- Eligibility of child and adult care institutions in CACFP;
- National per-meal value, meals served;
- May receive cash-in-lieu of foods.

## **SFSP**

#### §250.50

 Eligibility of service institutions (camps) in SFSP;

Percentage of adults to children;

Distribution based on # meals served.

#### **NSIP**

(formerly Nutrition Program for Elderly or NPE)

#### **Purpose**


The NSIP is intended to provide incentives to States and Tribes for the effective delivery of nutritious meals to older adults.

#### NSIP

(formerly Nutrition Program for Elderly or NPE)



- Assistance based on the Older Americans Act as amended;
- State Agency on Aging certifies number of meals;



- USDA purchases and provides donated foods as selected;
- May receive cash-in-lieu of food.

## **RA Agreement Requirements**

(11)

- Agreements are permanent;
- Must ensure that RA provides information changes to SDA;
- Allows incorporation of changes in Federal regulatory requirements;
- May be terminated with cause by either party with 30 days notice;

## **RA Agreement Contents**

## (12)

- Distribution & use of commodities in accordance with 7CFR 250;
- RA responsible to SDA for improper distribution, damage or loss through negligence;
- RA has right to assert claims;
- RA will take action to obtain restitution

## **Commodity Usage**

§250.13 (except single inventory programs)

- Commodities may not be sold, exchanged, of disposed without approval of USDA;
- Entitlement commodities may be transferred between like recipients only, with prior authorization of SDA;
- Entitlement commodities may be transferred between unlike recipients only with approval by FNS;

## **Commodity Usage**

- 14
- Bonus commodities may be transferred between all recipient agencies eligible to receive them with SDA authorization;
- Transfers must be documented and retained per recordkeeping requirements;
- SDA must monitor quantities of commodities in state warehouses and during agency reviews to salvage food not being utilized in a timely fashion;

## **Out of Condition Commodities**

#### §250.13(f)

- May be disposed of in accordance with instructions of the Department;
- If sold, all USDA markings must be obliterated (vendor overruns, salvage operations);
- If destroyed, must be in accordance with local sanitation laws and regulations;

# SDA Must Establish Review Procedures Encompassing

- RA eligibility;
- RA food ordering procedures;
- RA storage practices;
- RA inventory controls;
- RA reporting and recordkeeping practices.

## On-Site Review Cycles

- Schools five year cycle;
- Charitable Institutions & Summer Camps — as SDA identifies deficiencies warranting an on-site review;
- Processor every two years unless it is a multi-State processor (<u>might be</u> <u>changing</u>);
- State contracted storage annually.

## **Civil Rights**

- DAs, sub-distributing agencies, and RAs shall comply with the Department's nondiscrimination regulations (7CFR 15, 15a, 15b)...and
- FNS civil rights instructions to ensure that no person is discriminated against because of race, color, national origin, age, sex or handicap.

## **Program Complaints**

- Distributing Agencies shall investigate complaints received in connection with the distribution or use of donated foods
- Notify FNSRO of serious irregularities
- Retain evidence of investigations and actions taken
