

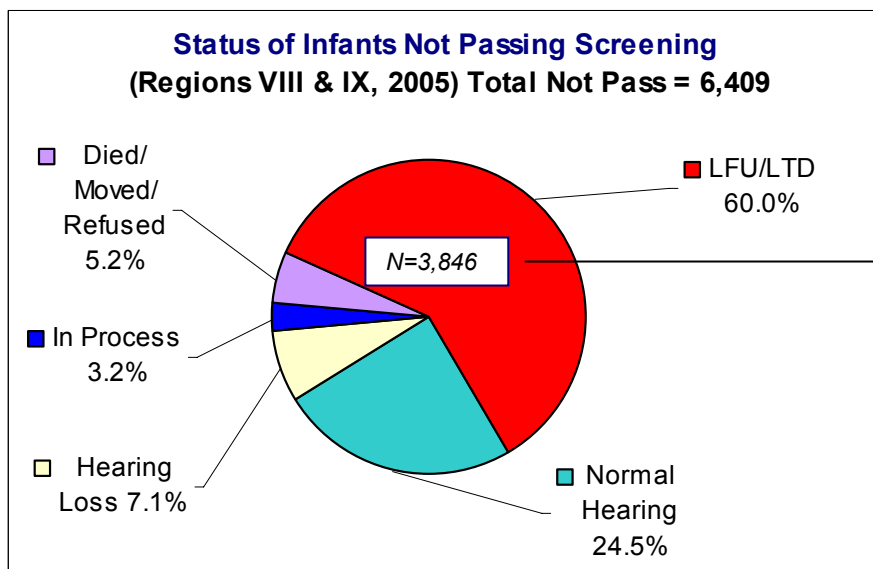
Summary of CDC-EHDI Survey Data by Region: Calendar Year 2005

Regions VIII and IX States

- MT*, UT, CO, ND*, SD, WY, ID, OR*, WA* (*Complete data for MT and ND was not available in 2005)

Summary of Key Data Indicators

- **Occurrent Births:** 286,230
- **Percent Not Passing (final screen):** 2.4% (6,409 infants)
- **Normal Hearing:** 1,571
- **Percent Screened:** 94.2% (269,739 infants)
- **No Diagnosis:** 4,382 (68.4%)
- **Hearing Loss / Incidence:** 456 / 1.7 per 1,000 screened



- **No Diagnosis:** Includes infants that are “In process,” “Died / Parents declined services,” “Non-residents or Moved out of jurisdiction,” and “Unable to contact / Unresponsive / Unknown”
- **LFU / LTD:** Loss to Follow-up / Loss to Documentation
 - Represents cases with no diagnosis due to reasons including “Unable to contact” or “Unresponsive” family and “Unknown” status
