

Missouri, 2005

Primary and secondary syphilis

- **CASES:** Missouri reported 147 cases in 2005.
- **RATES:** Missouri ranked 17 among 50 states + DC + 3 territories: 2.6 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 3.0 cases per 100,000 population.

Male-female rates of primary and secondary syphilis

- In Missouri, the rate among males was 4.8 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 5.1 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 0.4 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 0.9 per 100,000.

Racial disparities of primary and secondary syphilis

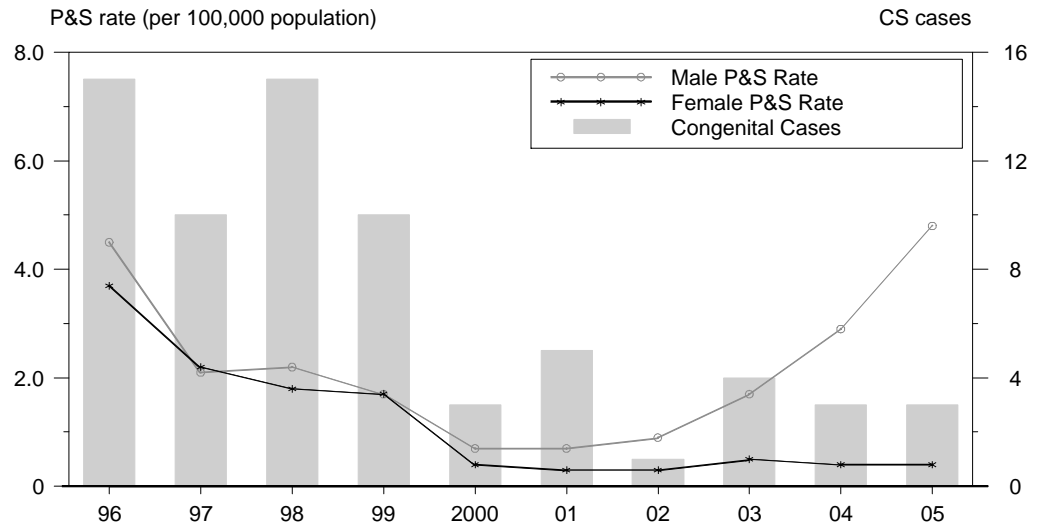
In Missouri, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 1.8 among whites, 8.0 among blacks, 4.0 among Hispanics, 1.2 among Asian/Pacific Islanders, and 0.0 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.

- The rate among blacks was 4.4 times that of whites.
- The rate among Hispanics was 2.2 times that of whites.

Congenital syphilis

- **CASES:** Missouri reported 3 cases in 2005.
- **RATES:** Missouri ranked 17 among 28 states + 2 territories reporting at least one congenital syphilis case: 3.9 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.0 cases per 100,000.
