SUBJECTS: Optional Use of Form FSA-1007 in Lieu of Peanut Weight Certificates
and
Revised Instructions for Preparing 2003-Crop Peanut Warehouse Receipts

Background:

The 2002 Farm Security and Rural Investment Act converted the Peanut Program from a quota price support system into a marketing assistance loan program. For the 2002 peanut crop year, United States Warehouse Act (USWA) warehouse operators were required to maintain peanut weight certificates in addition to the form FSA-1007. For the 2003 crop year, form FSA-1007, with alterations, may be used as a peanut weight certificate. For the 2003 crop year, there are changes to the warehouse receipt information. The warehouse receipt form has not changed so that existing supplies may be used.

Purpose:

This notice provides instructions for altering form FSA-1007 to make it acceptable as a peanut weight certificate for each assigned receiving or shipping location and warehouse. This notice also revises the instructions for properly preparing a warehouse receipt for peanuts.

Action:

ALTERATION OF FORM FSA-1007

USWA Warehouses (See Exhibit 1)

The USWA Peanut Warehouse Licensee may make the following alterations in order to use form FSA-1007 as an acceptable Nut Weight Certificate: (These alterations may be made by computer, typewriter, or rubber stamp.) [Note the location on the attached sample.] The fourth copy of this document, when used as a weight certificate, is the basic source document for movement of peanuts into and out of the warehouse for any purpose.

2	The fourth copy of the carbonless set.	This is the DACO copy. It is filed numerically by weight certificate number for both inbound and outbound movement. (see No. 6 instruction)
3	In Section "Q-Remarks"	Enter or print the Name and Location of the warehouse.
4	Above Section II	Check the box indicating whether the nuts are being weighed into or out of the warehouse.
5	At the signature in alteration "8"	Enter the date of the certificate manually next to the signature of the weigher.
6	Preprinted in the bottom right corner of the weight certificate.	Preprint the consecutive number of the certificate followed by a two place alpha buying point or alternate warehouse designation. Total Field length 11 characters. (Notes 2 and 3)
7	In Section II	Print the gross weight, tare weight, and net weight of the peanuts in items A, B, and C respectively.
8	In Section "Q" "Remarks"	Enter or print the following statement: "This certificate is issued by a weigher licensed under the United States Warehouse Act and the regulations thereunder." Following this statement is the signature of the licensed weigher. (Notes 1 and 2)
9	At the bottom	All copies have "Not Negotiable" preprinted on them.
10	At the top	Enter the Buying Point Number and Location

Notes: (1) Each location referred to in instruction No. 6 has at least one warehouse operator approved weigher. For scales to be usable, (i) warehouse operators must have control of the scales used to weigh peanuts, (ii) the scales must be inspected and certified as accurate by a State agency or a qualified scale company, (iii) a copy of the inspection report must be maintained at the warehouse office for the warehouse examiner's review, and (iv) the scale must be checked by the warehouse operator for accuracy on a routine basis.

(2) The fourth copy of FSA-1007 is the DACO copy and must be maintained in a numerical file for both inbound and outbound shipments. The examiner will be verifying inbound and outbound peanut movement by this document.

(3) The warehouse operator must contact KCCO – Tim Mehl, Chief, Warehouse License and Examination Division at (816) 926-6417 to submit their series of numbers to be used as weight certificate numbers (DACO Control Numbers). A separate series must be approved and used for each receiving and shipping location and warehouse.

Other Warehouses (See Exhibit 2)

Non-USWA peanut warehouse operators may make the following alterations to the form FSA-1007 so that it may be used as a peanut weight certificate: (These alterations may be made by computer, typewriter, or rubber stamp.) [Note the location on the attached sample.] The fourth copy of this document, when used as a weight certificate, is the basic source document for movement of peanuts into and out of the warehouse for any purpose.

7	In Section II	Print the gross weight, tare weight, and net weight of the peanuts in items A, B, and C respectively.
8	In Section “Q” “Remarks”	Enter or print the following statement: “This certificate is issued by a weigher approved by the warehouse operator.” Following this statement is the signature of the licensed weigher. (Notes 1 and 2)
9	At the bottom	All copies have “Not Negotiable” preprinted on them.
10	At the top	Enter the Buying Point Number and Location

Notes: (1) Each location referred to in instruction No. 6 has at least one warehouse operator approved weigher. For scales to be usable, (i) warehouse operators must have control of the scales used to weigh peanuts, (ii) the scales must be inspected and certified as accurate by a State agency or a qualified scale company, (iii) a copy of the inspection report must be maintained at the warehouse office for the warehouse examiner's review, and (iv) the scale must be checked by the warehouse operator for accuracy on a routine basis.

(2) The fourth copy of FSA-1007 is the DACO copy and must be maintained in a numerical file for both inbound and outbound shipments. The examiner will be verifying inbound and outbound peanut movement by this document.

(3) The warehouse operator must contact KCCO – Tim Mehl, Chief, Warehouse License and Examination Division, (816) 926-6417 to submit their series of numbers to be used as weight certificate numbers (DACO Control Numbers). A separate series must be approved and used for each receiving or shipping location and warehouse.

WAREHOUSE RECEIPT PREPARATION

Attached are the instructions for preparing a Peanut Warehouse Receipt. Exhibit 3 contains instructions for USWA warehouse receipts with a sample shown in Exhibit 4. Exhibit 5 contains instructions for other warehouse receipts with a sample shown in Exhibit 6.

Note: *Changes for crop year 2003 are italicized.*

Notes:

(1) Warehouse receipts may be used for a number of purposes including a Marketing Assistance Loan and proof of production for Loan Deficiency Payments.

(2) Warehouse operators wishing to participate in FSA Price Support Division's electronic warehouse receipt (EWR) Pilot Project for the 2003 crop year must contact the Kansas City Commodity Office (KCCO) to get number series for their warehouse receipts. KCCO will work with individuals, warehouse operators with approved EWR providers, and county offices to convert receipts to EWRs if paper warehouse receipts are issued prior to the EWR project being operational. Once the EWR pilot project is operational and the warehouse operator has signed on with an approved Provider, all warehouse receipts from that warehouse operator are issued as EWRs. If a producer/depositor requests a paper warehouse receipt in lieu of an EWR, the warehouse receipt is first issued as an EWR, then placed in suspension before issuing a paper warehouse receipt. The paper warehouse receipt must be surrendered to and cancelled by the warehouse operator before removing the EWR from suspension for final cancellation.

2003 Instructions For:

UNITED STATES WAREHOUSE ACT WAREHOUSE RECEIPT FOR PEANUTS

ORIGINAL - NEGOTIABLE

Used by USWA warehouse operators to warehouse receipt stored peanuts.

This form is completed by the warehouse operator and the original given to the depositor or holder.

Items A1 through A5 are generally preprinted on the form but may be entered by warehouse operators.

Items A1 through A5.

Fld Name / Item No.	Instruction
A1 Warehouse Receipt Number	Enter the warehouse receipt number. This number is sequential and is generally preprinted on the form or pre-assigned by a computer.
A2 CCC Code No.	Enter the CCC warehouse code number where the peanuts are stored for use by FSA in loan making. This number may be preprinted. Frequently the caption "CCC Code No." is preprinted and the number entered by the warehouse operator.
A3 License No.	Enter the United States Warehouse Act license number of the warehouse where the peanuts are stored. This number may be preprinted on the receipt. If not preprinted, the caption "License No." should be preprinted and the number entered by the warehouse operator.
A4 Name of Warehouse	Enter the name of the warehouse where the peanuts are stored. This name may be preprinted on the form. If not preprinted, it should be entered by the warehouse operator.
A5 Location City and State	Enter the location city and state of the warehouse where the peanuts are stored. This location may be preprinted on the form. If not preprinted, it should be entered by the warehouse operator.

Fld Name / Item No.	Instruction
<i>A6 (The Upper Right Hand Corner) Control Number</i>	For warehouses with multiple locations under one license, this control number is a preprinted consecutive number that enables the maintenance of records for one license.

Items B1 and B2 are entered by the warehouse operator.

Fld Name / Item No.	Instruction
B1 Received From	Enter the name of the depositor or holder entitled to the peanuts represented by the warehouse receipt.
B2 City, State	Enter the city and state location of the depositor or holder entitled to the peanuts represented by the warehouse receipt.

Items C1 through C18 are entered by the warehouse operator.

Fld Name / Item No.	Instruction
C1 Insurance	Check the appropriate box, if preprinted, or type whether the peanuts are “insured” or “uninsured”. If there are unusual terms to the insurance those terms should be specified in the block.
C2 Issue Date	Enter the date of issue of the warehouse receipt in the format “mm” (the month in 2 digits) and “dd” (the day in two digits) and “yy” (the year in 2 digits)
C3 Crop Year	Enter the crop year in 2 digits.
C4 Type	Check the appropriate box if preprinted or write in the space indicating the type of peanut represented by this warehouse receipt “Runner, Virginia, Spanish, or Valencia.
C5 Segregation/ Grade	Enter the segregation (or grade, if available) of peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt. The segregations are “Seg 1”, “Seg 2”, or “Seg 3”.

Fld Name / Item No.	Instruction
C6 Net Pounds	Enter the pounds <i>and tons</i> of peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt after foreign material, excess moisture, and LSK weight has been deducted.
C7 LSK Pounds	Enter the pounds <i>and tons</i> of loose shelled kernel peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt <i>before</i> foreign material and excess moisture has been deducted.
C8 Storage Date	Enter the date storage charges start in the format “mm” (the month in 2 digits) and “dd” (the day in two digits) and “yy” (the year in 2 digits). Storage start date is an average delivery date or a date negotiated with the depositor.
C9 How Stored	Enter the method of storing the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt. Check (if preprinted) or print “bags” or “bulk”.
C10 Status	Enter the status, or check the box if preprinted, “unshelled” or “shelled” in the space provided.
C11 Net Total Tons	Enter the <i>total number of pounds</i> , and tons to two decimal places right of the decimal. Print “Total” over “Net”. <i>This number is the total of items C6 and C7.</i>
C12 %Moisture	Enter the percent of moisture of the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt to two digits right of the decimal.
C13 %Foreign Material	Enter the percent of foreign material in the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt to two digits right of the decimal.
C14 %ELK	FOR VIRGINIA PEANUTS (SHELLED): Enter the percent of extra large kernels in the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt to two digits right of the decimal.
C15 %Fancy	FOR VIRGINIA PEANUTS (SHELLED): Enter the percent of fancy kernels in the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt to two digits right of the decimal.
C16 %Cracked or Broken Shells	FOR VALENCIA PEANUTS (UNSHELLED): Enter the percent of cracked or broken shells in the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt to two digits right of the decimal.

C17 % Discolored Shells	FOR VALENCIA PEANUTS (UNSHELLED): Enter the percent of discolored shells in the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt to two digits right of the decimal.

D3 % SMKRS	Enter the percent of sound mature kernels riding the screen in the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt to two digits right of the decimal.
D4 % Sound Splits	Enter the percent of sound split kernels riding the screen in the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt to two digits right of the decimal.
D5 % Total SMK	Enter the percent of <i>total</i> sound mature kernels in the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt to two digits right of the decimal. <i>[D5= D3 + D4]</i>
D6 % Other Kernels	<i>Enter the percent of Other Kernels in the peanuts represented by the warehouse receipt. NOTE: <u>Do Not</u> include % LSK.</i>
D7 Damage Splits (Gr)	OPTIONAL: Enter the number of grams of damaged split kernels in the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt to two digits right of the decimal.
D8 % Total Damage	Enter the percent of total damaged kernels in the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt to two digits right of the decimal.
D9 % Total Kernels	Enter the percent of total kernels in the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt to two digits right of the decimal. <i>[D9=D5+D6+D8]</i>

D10 % Hulls	Enter the percent of hulls in the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt to two digits right of the decimal.

D13 % Freeze Damage	Enter the percent of freeze damaged kernels in the peanuts represented by this warehouse receipt to two digits right of the decimal.

Both have been reduced for a shrinkage factor.” “For 2003-crop peanuts only, total loan value of the peanuts, Net Pounds and LSK Pounds represented by this warehouse receipt, calculated using USDA’s Price Table File issued on 7/11/03, is \$ _____ . Warehouse operator’s obligation shall be to deliver this total loan value upon demand.”</u> [In this statement, the warehouse operator enters the loan value of the peanuts after the “\$” sign.]

Items F1 through F3 are entered by the warehouse operator.
