Lake Winnebago Outlook – Updated January 8, 2009

The level of Lake Winnebago is holding at 2.34 feet today. The upriver supplies are holding near 3,300 cfs and are expected to remain stable while the cold conditions continue. Inflows into the lake measured at Oshkosh are about 2,700 cfs and have averaged 2,400 over the past week.

Two tainter gates at the Menasha dam are open at this time. The outflows measured at Appleton are steady at about 3,000 cfs.

The WDNR reported that both the upriver lakes as well as Lake Winnebago are ice-covered with numerous winter activities on-going.

The USACE will continue to monitor weather conditions today. The annual drawdown conference call will be held later today. Additional gate changes will be required later this week or early next week to achieve the desired target discussed at the conference call.
