1 Additional Allotments

A Background

On October 27, 2008, Notice BU-711 issued non-Federal County Office (Fund 87) and Federal (Fund 84) administrative expense allotments to State Offices for the period of the Continuing Resolution which is in effect through March 6, 2009.
