Subject FY 2001 Estimated Child Care and Development Fund (CCDF) Allocations and Estimated Earmarked and Set-Aside Discretionary Funds.

References The Child Care and Development Block Grant Act of 1990 as amended (CCDBG Act); Section 418 of the Social Security Act; Appropriations for the Department of Health and Human Services (P.L. 106-113); 45 CFR 98 and 99.

Purpose To inform States and Territories of their estimated FY 2001 CCDF allocations including earmarks for child care resource and referral and school-age child care activities, infant and toddler child care, and quality expansion activities. These earmarks are in addition to the amounts to be spent on quality and availability under section 658G of the CCDBG Act (i.e., such expenditures do not count toward meeting the “not less than four percent requirement.”)

Amounts available for FY 2001 Attached are tables for States and Territories showing the estimated amounts available for FY 2001. Please note that these tables include funds that are proposed in the Administration's budget request to Congress as well as the funds that are already appropriated, earmarked, and set-aside. The footnotes to the tables indicate the additional funds, earmark, and set-asides that are subject to Congressional approval. These include the \$817 million increase to the Discretionary Fund, the infant and toddler earmark, and the set-asides for child care research and a toll-free child care hotline operated by Child Care Aware.

Continuation of the earmark is requested in the FY 2001 President's Budget.</p> <p>2/ Totals are the sum of Mandatory, Discretionary and the Federal Share of the Matching Funds.</p> <p>3/ The proposed funding increase is not authorized in the FY 2001 appropriation, but is requested in the FY 2001 President's Budget. These funds are not included in the other columns or totals in these tables.</p> <p>4/ Ten million dollars was earmarked for research, demonstration, and evaluation in FY 2000. While the funds are included in the Discretionary appropriation for FY 2001, they are not earmarked for research. The President's Budget requests the continuation of the earmark in FY 2001.</p> <p>5/ The FY 2000 appropriation set-aside \$500,000 for a toll-free child care hotline to be operated by Child Care Aware. The President's Budget requests the continuation of this set-aside for FY 2001, and specifies that the amount come out of the \$19.1 million earmark for resource and referral and school-age care.</p> <p>Note: Estimated allocations for the Matching and Discretionary funds are based on counts used to determine FY 2000 allocations.
